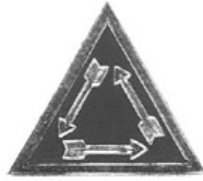


CHUMASH LODGE 90

Vigil Nomination Guidelines and Form



The Vigil Honor is a high mark of distinction and recognition reserved for those Arrowmen who, by reason of exceptional service, personal effort, and unselfish interest, have made distinguished contributions beyond the immediate responsibilities of their position of office to one or more of the following: **their unit, their lodge, the OA, Scouting, or their Scout Camp.**

Membership cannot be won by a person's conscious endeavor; it comes as recognition of their altruistic leadership in service. This fact should be given careful consideration in the nomination of any candidate. Under no circumstances should tenure in Scouting or the Order of the Arrow be considered as reason enough for a Vigil Honor recommendation.

The founder of the Order of the Arrow, Dr. E. Uner Goodman, said, "Membership and honors in the Order of the Arrow come to us not so much for what we have done, but rather as an incentive to continued and greater service." With this in mind, describe additional qualities or actions which merit consideration of this individual for the Vigil Honor.



Eligibility

To be eligible for the Vigil Honor, you must:

- Be a current dues paid member of Chumash Lodge 90 in good standing
- Be registered with the Boy Scouts of America
- Be a Brotherhood member of the Order of the Arrow for at least 2 years

Nomination

To be nominated for the Vigil honor you must:

- Fully meet the eligibility requirements
- Have a formal written nomination by someone else on the attached form

Selection

To be selected for a candidate for the vigil honor you must be chosen from the Vigil selection committee. The Vigil committee consists of the following:

- A chairman who oversees the meeting (appointed by the key 3)
- A committee of lodge members that are already vigil members, and other lodge members that are not eligible for selection.

If a lodge member is selected for the Vigil honor, a name in Lenne Lanape is chosen for him by the members of the selection committee. His name and information is submitted to the national office where he/she is to be approved by the national committee.
